



ABOUT ZETA BAR

Sydney's sexiest nightspot is Zeta Bar, sister to London's hottest bar, the award-winning Zeta London located at Hilton Park Lane.

The exclusive **Zeta Bar**, awarded Best Bar Presentation and Service (National AHA Awards), Cocktail List of the Year (6th Annual Bar Awards, 2006) and Australia's best new bar at the Australian Liquor Industry Awards (ALIA) 2005 is run by Grant Collins and Mike Enright, two of Sydney's foremost bartenders.

Zeta Bar is an opulent oasis in the heart of the city, filled with purple hues and dark wood tones. The inspired interior features indulgent spaces to sip cocktails. You can choose the discreet curtained dens or stand out on the garden terrace and view the illuminated QVB cityscape.

A sleek oak wood island bar runs the length of the main room flooded in a deep red and purple glow from huge glass lamps.

In the lounge there is an array of plush leather ottomans and dark timber tub chairs centered around a stylish oversized fireplace which burns sparkling glass rocks.

Originally from the UK, Mike Enright moved to Australia in 1999 and soon established himself at the forefront of the bar scene. His experience spans the Grand Pacific Blue Room, Hemmesphere, Jimmy Licks in Potts Point & also the award winning bar the Loft. Mike has won many awards for mixing cocktails & holds the title as Australian Liquor Industry Awards (ALIA) 'Bartender of the Year' 2004.

Mike has become a specialist in cocktail styling & cocktail design for industry magazines such as bartender, bars & clubs. He is also responsible for producing drink recipes for some of Australia's premier awards & fashion parties such as the Logies & Stella McCartney. Cocktail creations can regularly be found in consumer magazines such as Australian Gourmet Traveller, Harpers Bazaar, Vogue Entertaining & the Sydney Morning Herald's Good Living magazine. He has also been a regular feature for Foxtel television.

Mike talents have been called for overseas work. He was the mastermind behind the exclusive cocktail list at one of the sexiest bars in the world – *Ku De Ta*, Bali.

After a decade long career at some of the UK's finest bars including Bank Restaurant and Zander Bar, where in 2000 he was awarded the coveted title of "UK Bar Manager Of The Year", Grant Collins is not only one of Sydney's leading bartenders, but also one of the most highly regarded bar managers in Australia.

Most recently Grant spent four years at Sydney's Water Bar at W Hotel, where he led Water Bar to 23 industry awards including a ranking in Conde Nast Traveler's "Top 10 Bars in the World" (2004) and wallpaper Magazine's "Top Five Bars In The World" (2005),

as well as personally picking up “Australian Bar Manager Of The Year” at the 2003 and 2004 ALIA awards.

Both Grant and Mike have strong links with Zeta London and will liaise with the bar management to inspire them in creating ever more radical drinks for the Australian market.

Zeta Bar is set to become a Sydney icon. Located atop a breathtaking CBD rooftop terrace, Zeta reveals a never seen before viewpoint of the historical Queen Victoria Building and looks onto the length of George Street spanning down towards the harbour.

Tony Chi, award-winning designer, founder and president of New York City design firm tonychi and associates, is the mastermind behind this inspired elegance of Zeta.

As the creative force behind stylish spots around the world such as Asiate in New York, SPOON in Hong Kong, yè shanghai in Shanghai and Maduro bar in Tokyo, Chi has designed an interior for Zeta that arouses the senses:

- Glass pedestal perfume decanters in pink, red, orange and purple
- An Oakwood brown stone bar spanning the length of the space
- Three “Moroccan” style curtained dens
- Sydney’s only working fireplace located in a bar right in the heart of in our lounge area
- An array of plush leather ottomans, dark timber tub chairs and round fluted tables
- An outdoor terrace adjoined by a glass roof enclosure.

Staff will be dressed by internationally acclaimed Australian fashion designer, Tina Kalivas, who has worked on a number of exciting projects in both the Fashion and Film industries here in Australian and abroad.

Most notable of Kalivas’ projects was the creation of eight couture evening gowns for a prominent scene in the James Bond film, Die Another Day. Most recently Tina showcased her own label at Australian Fashion Week 2005.

Warm colours, cool drinks and exceptional service will all give Zeta Bar an undeniable edge, making it the city’s hottest nightspot for sipping a cocktail or simply relaxing on the outdoor terrace overlooking the stunning Queen Victoria Building.
